Dear Parents/Guardians.

As you know, school has been different over these past few months in response to the global pandemic. All students will be receiving a report card which reflects their learning prior to spring break as well as a summary of the learning opportunities provided between March and June 2020. Therefore, the report card may not provide the same amount of rich, detailed feedback that is usually provided on a final report card.

What to expect:

- Third term comments will focus on Literacy, Numeracy, Social Emotional Learning and Physical Health. Other subject areas may not include a comment.
- The report card will include comments; performance standards (K-3) and, letter grades for Gr 4-5 are optional for third term.
- Students will receive a final summary mark for each of the curricular areas for this year, along with a summary comment about what your child is able to do, ways to support their learning and areas that may require further support.
- If your child has an Individual Education Plan (IEP), the report card will have comments in relation to the goals and expected learning outcomes outlined through the IEP.
- Attendance for Term 1 and 2 will be included on the report card, Term 3 will be blank.

Report Distribution:

- Students attending in-class learning at Oaklands on <u>Mondays & Tuesdays</u> will receive their report cards on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>June 23rd</u>.
- Students attending in-class learning at Oaklands on <u>Wednesdays & Thursdays</u> (including our ESW families) will receive their report cards on Thursday, June 25th.
- For families who have their children at home and are learning remotely, please pick up your child's report card in person on the date(s) noted by their classroom teacher. (Please refer to the email your teacher has sent to you). Alternatively, you pick-up your child's report card from our school office on Monday, June 29th, Tuesday, June 30th, or Thursday, July 2nd between the hours of 8:00am and 3:00pm.

We acknowledge that this has been a time of significant change for families, students and educators. Thank you for understanding the need to adapt to the situation by doing things differently, including reporting student learning.
