Thrifty Foods – The Smile Card Program is a significant part of the PAC's annual budget; every year they donate up to \$3000. In the past we have used these funds for field trips, classroom support, and new technology purchases. Smile Cards are available in the school office.

Take the Smile Card with you to any Thrifty Foods location when you go grocery shopping. Ask the cashier to load any amount you wish onto the card before having your grocery order rung through. Pay for the card load with cash, debit card or credit card. Ring the grocery order through and pay for the order with your Smile Card.

When the card balance is running low, load it again to continue to support the Oaklands PAC every time you shop. Loaded Smile Cards can also be used to pay for groceries delivered to your door.
