Hello Parents,

The PAC Executive is pleased to announce that we are bringing Nikki Lineham, math expert and educator extraordinaire, back to Oaklands for 2020. Nikki will be coming to you via Zoom on **Tuesday, October 20**th **starting at 6PM.** This year, Nikki will be delivering two separate sessions designed to help guide parents in helping their children at different ages.



Session One (from 6PM to 6:50PM):

Number Sense Support for K-3: In this zoom session we will share games, activities and routines that you can do at home to support mathematics and building number sense. We will also briefly discuss the current math curriculum and how it differs from the math classes you may have experienced when you were in school. Resources will be shared with all attendees that will support you in making math visual, accessible and fun at home!

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Session Two (from 7PM to 7:50PM):

Digging Deeper into Math Concepts for Grades 4/5: In this zoom session we will explore a few math 4/5 concepts conceptually, which means exploring why the procedures work and how they work as well as when we might use them to solve problems. Some parents find the "new math" baffling because they never experienced it themselves and so this session will be geared for parents who are open to understanding different ways of thinking about and doing mathematics so that they can better support their children at home.
