We anticipate that by the 2022-2023 school year, all schools province wide will be using the Proficiency Scales language.

Regardless as to where students are in their development of skills and competencies, our classrooms and hallways are filled with evidence of growth, perseverance and the joy of learning. We are committed to supporting your children with their learning and maintaining Oaklands as a safe place to belong.
