To apply for a transfer request you must complete a transfer form during the K-12 Student Transfer Process week of February 12-16, 2024. We will not be accepting the transfer letters in our office before that time.

Any student entering Grade 6 can enroll in Late French Immersion in the Greater Victoria School District. Registration for Late French Immersion will occur during the week of January 29 - February 2, 2024. Late French Immersion is offered at four dual-track middle schools: Arbutus Global, Central, Lansdowne and Shoreline. No prior knowledge of French is expected or required.
