Re: Status of Seismic Update at Oaklands Elementary

Dear Oaklands Elementary Parent Advisory Council Executive,

Thank you for your January 16th letter inquiring about the status of the seismic upgrade project for Oaklands Elementary School. On behalf of the District, I understand your curiosity and eagerness to know more, as this is both an exciting and complex project.

In May 2023, the structural upgrade was added to the five-year capital plan for the Greater Victoria School District (GVSD). The project has yet to receive funding approval. After funding is approved, we will also require a complete drawing set to obtain a building permit from the City of Victoria prior to the start of any repairs. In the interim, shoring has been erected to the school under the direction of a structural engineer as a proactive measure.

At this time, we are unable to provide an anticipated start date or confirm where affected students would be housed during the upgrade; however, we can provide the following information:

- GVSD has been working with the heritage planner at the City of Victoria as well as a variety of
 engineers to establish timelines, cost estimates, and repair details.
- Through a structural engineer, GVSD is in the process of obtaining a suitable team that has the
 experience needed for this type and age of repair. The team will include a cost analysis expert,
 an architect, as well as mechanical and electrical consultants.
- A structural engineer has also been working to determine viable repair options. One of the three
 options has been identified as the most suitable choice, as it did not decrease classroom size
 and includes repairs to the full scope of the exterior of the building along with the structural
 elements. The team would have to remove the complete outer face on two sides of the 1912
 building. Then, new columns would be erected and tie into the current floor system. The
 cornices and modillions would also be tied in and made structurally sound as would the band
 around the building. From initial discussions, the exterior bricks on the two sides would be
 removed for the repair and then replaced once repairs complete.
- A materials engineer has and will continue to be consulted throughout the project.

Thank you again for reaching out and look forward to communicating regularly as this project advances.
