Thank you for supporting Oaklands School.

The City of Victoria have a project on Lionel Street planned for this Spring. They will be constructing a sidewalk letdown on Lionel Street, aligned with the school gate entrance (see photo below). This work is an outcome of the 2022-2023 Ready Step Roll process that Oaklands Elementary participated in with the CRD and City. Through this process, the school community identified the need for a sidewalk letdown to allow bicycles and other mobility devices to access the school entrance path from the roadway.

The scheduled week for this work is still TBD, but we anticipate it to take 1-2 weeks, with temporary traffic diversions and parking removal at times. The scope of the work will include some minor sidewalk reconstruction, and introducing some new yellow curb adjacent to the new ramp, to ensure parked vehicles do not encroach on this access point.

School Newsletter for Kindergarten & Grade 1

Kindergarten and Grade 1 Immunizations

To make routine immunization more accessible to children, Island Health is offering in-school immunization clinics for students in Kindergarten & Grade 1 at your school this year. Kindergarten & Grade 1 students who are eligible for routine immunizations (excluding COVID-19 & influenza) will receive a consent package through the school. If your child doesn't receive a consent package, this may mean your child is up to date, or has an immunization appointment booked at a health unit.

If your child receives a package, follow the instructions included and return the signed form to the school as soon as possible. Parents/guardians may provide consent or refusal for each/all vaccines. Students will only be offered immunizations in a school-based clinic with the consent of a parent/guardian.

Parents/guardians are welcome to be with their child at the school on the day of the clinic, however, there is no expectation for parents/guardians to be present. A trusted adult from your child's school, such as your child's teacher or teacher's assistant, or Public Health Nurse will be available to provide support to your child while they receive their immunizations.

Immunizations will be provided at the school for Kindergarten & Grade 1 students on April 25, 2024. $\,$.




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Borrow a Bike Lock – Now Available at Oaklands Elementary
