

Dear Oaklands Families,

On behalf of SD61 and Oaklands school, I would like to share an update on the work that will be happening with Oaklands school's 1913 building.

In spring of 2023, it was determined that the south and west facades of the 1913 building (see image below) require structural upgrading, due to corrosion of reinforced concrete mullions and window headers. For this reason there is temporary shoring installed inside the affected classrooms to ensure the building is safe for continued use.

We have received funding from the ministry and will be moving ahead with renovations of the 1913 building. In addition to the structural work, we will use this opportunity to upgrade the HVAC in all affected classrooms, replacing the existing radiant heating panels with new, energy-efficient unit ventilators.

Work is anticipated to begin in early 2025 and be complete by the end of summer 2026. The safety of students and staff is of utmost importance during this process, and school district staff will work with the selected contractor to ensure the highest level of safety protections and procedures are implemented when the renovations start.

Once the renovations begin, we will be relocating nine divisions (Divisions 1-9) 2.7 km to <u>Uplands School</u> campus for the school day. This includes all our grades 4 and 5 students (Divisions 1-6) as well as the grade 3 students (Divisions 7, 8 and 9) in the 1913 building. The remaining 13 divisions (Divisions 10 - 22) will remain at the Oaklands campus. This includes all of our kindergarten students.

A bussing transportation plan will be organized by the district and communicated to families at a later date. Oaklands School will remain the drop-off and pick-up location for students and families so that there is no disruption to out-of-school care and activities.

We will continue to update families regularly over the coming months leading up to the start of this project.

Head Lice

There have been cases of head lice at Oaklands. Head lice are common in BC communities. Although they are a bother, *head lice are not a health risk.*

You can help by:

Learn how to check for live lice using wet combing and be aware of the recommended treatment options https://www.islandhealth.ca/sites/default/files/2018-08/head-lice-management.pdf

- Check the heads of all family members for head lice weekly using the wet combing method.
- It is possible to have head lice more than once; therefore, weekly wet combing checks help identify head lice re-infestations.
- If live lice are found using the wet combing method, treat only family members with live lice.
- Encourage your children not to share hair accessories, hats, combs, brushes, or anything that comes in contact with your child's head.
- Remind family and friends about the importance of routine head checks.
- Tie back long hair to help avoid getting head lice.

If you are not sure what you are looking for, or you find that your child has head lice, please call the Public Health Nurse for more information.
